The submission should be no less than 1.5 minutes and cover 8 of the prompts listed on page 4. There is an additional resource, Attachment A that explains the answer to each of these prompts, including a video for some of the responses. These should not be copied verbatim. Content will be judged on creativity, accurate content, along with the views the video gets across our social media channels.

- Does a baby that is surrendered go into the foster care system?
- We have Safe Haven Laws; why do we need the Baby Boxes too?
- What is in the orange bag that is in the Baby Box for the birth mother to take?
- How does a Baby Box work?
- Do babies get adopted in the same state they are surrendered?
- How do you adopt a Safe Haven Baby?
- How do I get a Baby Box for my city?
